

# *Resolution of the Wisconsin State Genealogical Society*

*WHEREAS the late Mrs. Nancy Hawkinson was a charter member of St. Croix Valley Genealogical Society (SCVGS), which was founded in April 1979 as an affiliate member of WSGS, and*

*WHEREAS Nancy was the editor of the PIPOST newsletter for 35 years (140 issues), which included writing articles, compiling information, and mailing them out four times a year, and*

*WHEREAS Nancy spent many years working on various indexing projects and searchable databases to help others that were researching in the Hudson area, and*

*WHEREAS Nancy volunteered two days a week in the History Room of the Hudson Public Library, whose founding she spearheaded, one day a week at the St. Croix Historical Society, answered queries submitted via email or mail, and*

*WHEREAS Nancy played a key role in connecting the Department of Veteran's Affairs with a descendant of a previously unknown soldier who had died during the bombing of Pearl Harbor so that his remains could be returned for a family burial, and*

*WHEREAS Nancy transcribed cemeteries and photographed gravestones in both Pierce and St. Croix Counties, Wisconsin, NOW THEREFORE,*

*BE IT RESOLVED that the Wisconsin State Genealogical Society expresses to Mrs. Nancy Hawkinson its sincerest thanks and deepest appreciation for her years of dedication, service and involvement in numerous other projects, and*

*BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Wisconsin State Genealogical Society hereby inducts Mrs. Nancy Hawkinson into the Virginia V. Irvin Volunteer Hall of Fame.*
