Service to be honored should occur in the year prior to the application being submitted. The honoree will be notified of their award in late February.

The late Mrs. Virginia V. Irvin distinguished herself through years of volunteer service to the Wisconsin genealogical community rendered through the Wisconsin State Genealogical Society, in which she served in many capacities including the creation of cemetery transcriptions, serving as Queries Editor and as Assistant Editor of the *Wisconsin State Genealogical Society Newsletter*, maintaining the Publications program of WSGS, operating the WSGS Bookstore, and as Editor of the *WSGS Newsletter* for over fourteen years, single-handedly producing a publication noted for timeliness, reliability and usefulness of content. She also concurrently served as Treasurer of the Wisconsin State Genealogical Society and brought the Society from a state of financial disarray to one of true financial stability to the extent that the Society able to make significant material contributions to research resources in Wisconsin through major gifts to the Wisconsin Historical Society.
